

# Inflatable Lifelike Donkey Unpacking Instructions

1



1. Carefully open end of plastic bag and remove donkey.
2. Make sure donkey is at normal room temperature.
3. Get a pen or marker to mark each piece of tissue paper as it is removed.
4. Get a 2 gallon or larger ziploc style bag to hold the tissue paper and store the donkey when you want to put him away.



Unfold donkey at center.

Unfold the next section.

Now unfold the last section toward you.

Now pull the paper on top toward you. Don't pull it completely off yet, just take it off the top.

Now open the folded donkey along the length. The way mine was laid out it unfolded to the left. Try to not move or tear the paper as you are unfolding the donkey.

Now open the folded donkey along the length the other way. The way mine was laid out it now unfolded to the right.

Now remove the first piece of paper which is covering the donkey's head. Mark it as #6, fold it carefully and put it in your plastic storage bag.

Unfold this second pair of legs just like you did the first pair and line them up with the other legs. You have now released the piece of tissue paper and it will be removed next.

Remove the piece of paper from the area outlined below, mark it as #3, fold it and put it in your storage bag for later.

Now straighten the lower legs back out and you will release the tissue paper held between the legs.

Now remove the tissue paper, label it #2, fold it and put it in your plastic storage bag. You're almost there!

Straighten your donkey's legs and belly and smooth the plastic where you can. Then remove the last piece of paper from under the tail and back end, mark it #1, fold it and put it away in your plastic storage bag.
